Effective **May 1** as part of the extended Stay at Home Order issued by Governor Pritzker, it is **MANDATORY** to wear a face mask or face covering when in public.



NO MASK NO SERVICE



- The mandates requires when out in public, people over the age of 2 & who can medically tolerate to do so, wear a face mask in public.
- This includes when people are working and or visiting essential businesses such as grocery stores, pharmacies & gas stations.
- In the event a face mask is not possible, face coverings will be accepted.

MPORTANT

- As part of the face mask requirement, the Governor has stated that store operators have the right to turn away customers not wearing a face mask or covering.
- People in public not wearing a face mask maybe subject to a citation or fine.

INFORMATION

• NOTE – it is not required to wear a face mask while in your car or at home.
