We hope this email finds you, your staff and families continuing to do well! In this week's Information Safety & COVID-19 newsletter for April 24, there are several key updates regarding COVID-19 including yesterday's announcements from Governor Pritzker.

Ramadan Mubarak – we wanted to take a moment to acknowledge the start of Ramadan & wish those of you and your families celebrating this time, good health & happiness!

UPDATE Illinois Stay At Home Order Extended – as announced in yesterday's COVID-19 news conference by Governor Pritzker, the Illinois Stay at Home Order has been now been extended from the end of April through May 30 with some revisions noted below made from the April Stay at Home Order.

- **Outdoor Recreation** – some state parks, fishing & boating activities as well golf courses may start a phased re-opening in May under strict safety guidelines.
- **New Essential Businesses** – Greenhouses, garden centers & nurseries will be permitted to re-open as essential business provided they follow designated COVID-19 safety guidelines.
- **Non Essential Business** – Retail stores not considered as essential businesses will have the option to re-open in May provided they follow designated COVID-19 safety guidelines & only fulfill phone & online orders for curbside pick-up & delivery.

UPDATE Face Mask –effective Friday **May 1**, the entire state of Illinois will require everyone over the age of 2 & who can medically tolerate to do so, to wear a face mask when in public. In the event a face mask is not possible, a face covering will be accepted.

- **Requirement** – The face mask mandates requires when people are working & or visiting essentials businesses such as grocery stores, pharmacies & **gas stations**. People out in the public not wearing a mask maybe subject to a citation and or fine. **Note** – it is not required to wear a face mask while in a car and or home.
- **No Mask, No Service** – today Governor Pritzker also announced once the state wide face mask requirement goes into place on May 1, it is acceptable for store operators to turn away customers inside their stores who are not wearing a face mask or covering.



- **Individual Town Face Mask** - in addition to the state face mask requirement, the following towns have or will be implementing their own face mask mandates taking effect **prior** to the state requirements on May 1:
 - **Buffalo Grove** – as of April 24
 - **Cicero** – as of April 16
 - **NEW Deerfield** – as of April 22
 - **NEW Des Plaines** – as of April 24
 - **NEW Evanston** – as of April 23
 - **Glenview** – as of April 19 stations impacted include:
 - **Highland Park** – as of April 20
 - **La Grange Park** – as of April 27
 - **Morton Grove** – as of April 15
 - **NEW Niles** – as of April 17
 - **Northbrook** – as of April 20
 - **North Chicago** – as of April 24
 - **NEW North Riverside** – as of April 23
 - **NEW Oak Brook** – as of April 24
 - **NEW Oak Lawn** – as of April 24
 - **NEW Park Ridge** – as of April 25
 - **Skokie** – as of April 16 stations impacted include:
 - **NEW Tinley Park** – as of April 24
 - **University Park** – as of April 24
 - **Wilmette** – as of April 20

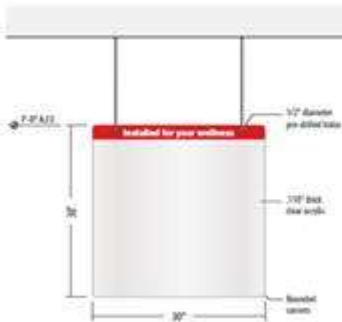
